By analyzing the above, three main reasons for learning English can be distinguished:

Therefore, almost every university in this country has engineering departments. There are also about 40 engineering colleges across the country. Therefore, we can surely say that learning English in the field of innovative technologies and education offers great opportunities for future specialists to conduct research and improve their skills. By studying specialized terms, an English-speaking professional often has access to learn variety of information or advancements that are implemented in other foreign countries.

As we prepare future engineers, we should take into account that they have to study not only ordinary English but especial technical English as well. First, we tell them that English is a polysemantic language. Sometimes even the simplest and most familiar words can have a completely different meaning in technical language. Therefore, a general knowledge of English may not be enough to understand its meaning. For example, when we say the word "table", in

ordinary English we imagine a piece of furniture with a flat top supported by legs, for eating, writing or working at. But, in engineering, it has the meanings as "plan" or "schedule". Another example: the verb "build" in technical language can mean the vertical gap between the laid bricks, and the word "leader" can mean the channel of the air heating system. Another examples are: "film" – not movie, but a layer on smth., "nut" – not purposed for eating, but used to fasted pieces of two steel, "apron" – not type of cloth which is worn while cooking, but parking area for aircrafts, and etc.

As we can see from the examples, students of technical higher education institutions may encounter completely different aspects of the English language. Today, a good engineer should know English well enough to read specialized literature in his field, who is able to master new knowledge in the relevant field and constantly improve himself.

- 2) Speaking about the second aspect of language learning, communication is one of the main conditions for establishing successful relationships in both personal and professional life. Communication skills are one of the most important personal qualities in professions that involve active interaction with other people. The career of construction engineer can also be attributed to such professions. Today, English is the native language of more than 300 million people around the world, and the second language of another 200 million people. English is also recognized as one of the six official languages of the United Nations. From these dates, we see that learning English is very essential today.
- 3) In order for a civil engineer to perform his professional work effectively, he should be perfect as an individual, his social skills should be highly developed, he should be able to solve problems related to the career or in the work of the team, in order to overcome misunderstandings. Learning English also contributes to the formation of professional skills that embody such moral, social and professional values. Studying the culture or life manners of another nation and the social and political structure of another state through language learning, future engineers develop the ability to conduct with their co-workers from other countries and develop ability to keep interpersonal relationships. Getting to know the living conditions, interests and problems of co-workers abroad helps young people to define their goals, spiritual and moral values in modern society, as well as to gain self-confidence and the need for personal perfection.

The educational potential of a foreign language course in the formation of the personality of a future specialist is concentrated in the course itself. The aim of studying English is to read and understand the main literature in your field of study in English and to be able to express it orally and in written. In addition, it is necessary be able to communicate in English with colleagues in various life and work situations.
