Metadata Policy for information describing items in the repository

- 1. Anyone may access the metadata free of charge.
- 2. The metadata may be re-used in any medium without prior permission for not-for-profit purposes provided:
 - (a) the OAI Identifier or a link to the original metadata record are given
- (b) Repository of Belarusian National Technical University (BNTU) is mentioned
- 3. The metadata must not be re-used in any medium for commercial purposes without formal permission.

Data Policy for full-text and other full data items

- 1. Anyone may access full items free of charge.
- 2. Single copies of full items can be:
- (a) reproduced, displayed or performed, and given to third parties in any format or medium
- (b) for personal research or study, educational, or not-for-profit purposes without prior permission or charge. provided:
 - (a) the authors, title and full bibliographic details are given
 - (b) a hyperlink and/or URL are given for the original metadata page
 - (c) the original copyright statement is given
 - (d) the original rights permission statement is given
 - (e) the content is not changed in any way
- 3. Full items must not be sold commercially in any format or medium without formal permission of the copyright holders.
- 4. Some full items are individually tagged with different rights permissions and conditions.
- 5. This repository is not the publisher; it is merely the online archive.

Content Policy for types of document & data set held

- 1. This is an institutional or departmental repository.
- 2. Repository of Belarusian National Technical University (BNTU) holds all types of materials.
- 3. Items are individually tagged with:
 - (a) their version type and date.
 - (b) their peer-review status.
 - (c) their publication status.
- 4. Principal Languages: Russian; English

Submission Policy concerning depositors, quality & copyright

- 1. Items may only be deposited by accredited members, and employees of the organisation, or their delegated agents.
- 2. Authors may only submit their own work for archiving.

- 3. Eligible depositors must deposit bibliographic metadata for all their publications.
- 4. Eligible depositors must deposit full texts of all their publications.
- 5. The administrator only vets items for the eligibility of authors/depositors, relevance to the scope of Repository of Belarusian National Technical University (BNTU), valid layout & format, and the exclusion of spam.
- 6. The validity and authenticity of the content of submissions is the sole responsibility of the depositor.
- 7. Items can be deposited at any time, but will not be made publicly visible until any publishers' or funders' embargo period has expired.
- 8. Any copyright violations are entirely the responsibility of the authors/depositors.
- 9. If Repository of Belarusian National Technical University (BNTU) receives proof of copyright violation, the relevant item will be removed immediately.

Preservation Policy

- 1. Items will be retained indefinitely.
- 2. Repository of Belarusian National Technical University (BNTU) will try to ensure continued readability and accessibility.
 - (a) Items will be migrated to new file formats where necessary.
- 3. Repository of Belarusian National Technical University (BNTU) regularly backs up its files according to current best practice.
- 4. The original bit stream is retained for all items, in addition to any upgraded formats.
- 5. Items may be removed at the request of the author/copyright holder.
- 6. Acceptable reasons for withdrawal include:
 - (a) Proven copyright violation or plagiarism
 - (b) Legal requirements and proven violations
 - (c) National Security
 - (d) Falsified research
- 7. Withdrawn items are deleted entirely from the database.
- 8. Withdrawn items' identifiers/URLs are not retained.
- 9. The metadata of withdrawn items will not be searchable.
- 10. If necessary, an updated version may be deposited.
- 11. In the event of Repository of Belarusian National Technical University (BNTU) being closed down, the database will be transferred to another appropriate archive.
